The Massachusetts General Hospital is seeking a talented and dedicated physician to serve as Program Director for the Global Health Collaborative (GHC) in Mbarara, Uganda.

MGH Global Health leverages Mass General's rich, 200-year legacy of leadership and innovation to build long-term, generation-spanning relationships and programs that improve the health and well-being of the world's most vulnerable populations and prepare tomorrow's health leaders, educators, and innovators.

The Global Health Collaborative (GHC) is a joint effort between MGH, the Mbarara University of Science & Technology (MUST), and the Mbarara Regional Referral Hospital (MRRH) and collectively oversees 14 research protocols, multiple departmental partnerships, a safety and security detail, and hosts over 200 visitors per year. This is a dynamic research and clinical care environment, hosting numerous international trainees, clinicians, and investigators every year.

Reporting to and under the general supervision of the Executive Director of MGH Global Health, the Program Director of the GHC oversees the Collaborative growth and development. Working with leadership of MUST and MRRH in Uganda, and leadership of MGH in Boston, this position will help set the strategic vision and short-term operational plans for the GHC.

The Program Director is responsible and accountable for creating efficient and effective systems to support the daily operations of the GHC, including international research projects, expansion of clinical partnerships with MGH, clinical teaching and training, and logistical support for MGH expat staff and visitors. The Program Director directly supervises MGH staff who live in Mbarara and work for the GHC. Strong applicants are self-motivated, flexible, patient, able to organize priorities and complete tasks, and sensitive to a diverse community environment and customs.

The successful candidate will have completed residency training in internal medicine, family practice, or medicine/pediatrics, and be Board certified/eligible. Previous international clinical or academic experience required. Training in Tropical Medicine or Public Health, preferred. A Massachusetts Medical License will be required. Salary commensurate to experience, full benefits, and relocation stipend is provided.
