Dr. Michael Siegel is a professor in the Department of Community Health Sciences at the Boston University School of Public Health. He is the principal investigator on two grants to study approaches to reducing firearm violence. With funding from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, Dr. Siegel created a comprehensive database of firearm laws in all 50 states covering the years 1991 to the present. He is studying the impact of these laws on firearm homicide and suicide rates. With funding from the National Institute of Justice, Dr. Siegel is researching the differential impact of state firearm laws on homicide rates by race and ethnicity.
