



Gun Violence Prevention Challenge Summit & Hack-a-thon

Peter T. Masiakos, MS, MD, FACS, FAAP is a Pediatric Surgeon and the Director of Pediatric Trauma Service at Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH). He is an Associate Professor of Surgery at Harvard Medical School and an Associate Visiting Surgeon at MGH, where he has a clinical interest in pediatric trauma care and has become a vocal injury prevention advocate. He has been involved in successfully educating the Massachusetts legislature and the US Congress on the inherent risks that All Terrain Vehicles (ATVs) pose on children and testified both at the Massachusetts state house and at the consumer product safety commission on the need for new legislation which would prohibit the use of ATVs by children. As a result of this work, the first law imposing an age restriction on ATV use in the United States was enacted on July 31st, 2010. Dr. Masiakos continues to work alongside

Massachusetts State Legislators as he evaluates the outcomes on several other injury prevention laws that have been passed, including laws addressing safe driving, youth sports concussion, firearms and junior drivers (JOL).
