Pia M. Mauro, PhD, is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Epidemiology at the Columbia University Mailman School of Public Health. Dr. Mauro focuses on substance use epidemiology, particularly individual and structural influences of substance use disorder (SUD) treatment access and utilization. Dr. Mauro's work focuses SUD and mental health service co-location, marijuana epidemiology, and working with hard-to-reach populations. She recently received a career development award through the National Institute on Drug Abuse to estimate associations between substance use policies and treatment over time by gender and race/ethnicity. Dr.

Mauro completed a post-doctoral fellowship in the Substance Abuse Epidemiology Training Program at Columbia University and obtained a PhD from the Department of Mental Health at the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health. She also has a background in psychology from the University of Notre Dame, and professional experience in SUD treatment program evaluations.
